COMMUNITY ANNOUNCEMENTS:

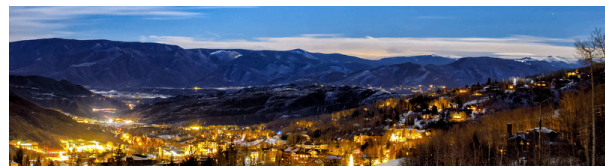
